Education level	IES Federico García Lorca is a Secondary Education School (Middle/High). The age of our students spans from 12 to 16 (ESO), being post-compulsory (Bachillerato) from 16 to 18.
Collaboration subjects/modules of the Language Assistant	The language assistants will help with the content subjects included in our school bilingual program: Biology, Physical Education, History, Maths, Physics-Chemistry. Philosophy is sometimes included in their schedule with the Bachillerato students. Assistants may also help with English as a Foreign language, in the English classes. The teachers will always help and guide the assistants in their classes, asking them to prepare presentations, games, communicative activities, etc.



Information about the town neighborhood	Churriana de la Vega (also popularly called Churriana) is a Spanish municipality, belonging to the province of Granada, in Andalusia. It is located in the central part of the Vega de Granada, just about 6 km from the provincial capital.
