Churriana de la Vega (also popularly called Churriana) is a Spanish municipality, belonging to the province of Granada, in Andalusia. It is located in the central part of the Vega de Granada, just about 6 km from the provincial capital.

This website will show maps of the trail, instructions, and bus routes to get there. Sierra Nevada is a great place to go skiing. It is very inexpensive compared to the US. You can rent skis, boots, poles, and a helmet for little money. It is only a 30-45 minute drive from the city.



# **Getting to school**

Some of our assistants in previous years used to bike from Granada to our school. Others prefer to use the public transport, which is quite convenient and will leave you at the school gates.

You will need **bus numbers** 156 or 150 to get to Churriana. Both buses **leave from Palacio de Congresos:**

Bus rides are cheaper if you have the green bus card. You can check the prices here: <u>https://ctagr.es/sistema-tarifario/tarjeta-de-transporte/tarjeta-de-0-saltos</u>. If you do not have this bus card it will cost a bit more. This card can be purchased and reloaded at book shops, tobacco shops and some other shops or shopping centres. The card is valid for buses and metro. It can also be reloaded at metro stops with a ticket machine.

The app "Moovit" explains how to get from one stop to another using different bus lines.

The bus ride is about 15 minutes from Palacio de Congresos to the front gate of the school. Compared to most other language assistants, the commute to Churriana de la Vega is one of the shortest and easiest!



## **Accommodation**

Churriana de la Vega is a small town, so all our assistants usually choose to live in Granada city center. The bus will leave from Palacio de Congresos, so an apartment within walking distance to there is advisable, so you don't need to pay for two buses.
